Weekly Volunteer Orientation

Volunteer Levels

To simplify our needs, we have broken down the volunteer levels into three tiers. Choose the one that suits your availability and interest.

Tier I: Event Volunteers: Interest is primarily in being available on call for helping with events or date specific volunteer hours.
(6 months – 1 year)

Tier II: Program Volunteers: Interest is in longer term commitment to overall mission and program building goals. Versatile, enjoy ongoing tasks, staying busy and having ownership of projects.
(6 months – 1 year)

Tier III: Talent Volunteers: Short term, function specific, may stay, may move on, specifically interested in offering hours towards a particular area, skill, or talent.
(3-6 months.)
